Curriculum:

Language/Mathematics

In language we will be reviewing the third family of sounds (k,l,o,v,d,g). We will be blending all three families of sounds together to make three letter words. The older children will be working on memorizing their sight words (and, the, to, etc.) which help connect words for reading full sentences. In mathematics, we will be reviewing our tens, both in symbol and quantity. We will be constructing combinations of ten, an early form of addition (1+9=10, 2+8=10, 3+7=10, etc.).

Cultural

We will be studying the continent of Asia this month. If any parents or grandparents have anything to share with our class about the cultures, traditions and holidays of Asia, please let us know. If you have any traditional clothing, jewelry, or memorabilia and would like to share them with the children during a circle time, we'd love to have you.

Life Science

In zoology, we will be learning about mammals and what differentiates them from other types of animals. We will also take a close look at the horse as a mammal and study the different parts of its body. In geography we will learn about volcanoes and mountains around the world.

Word of the month:

Equality (n): the state or instance of being equal, especially, the state of enjoying equal rights as political, economic, and social.

Valentine's Day:

On Monday, February 14th we will celebrate Valentine's Day by doing a "Circle of Love." We will discuss what love means and the children will be given an opportunity to stand up and tell us who they love and why. The students will have the opportunity to make cards for family and friends throughout the week, a Valentine making station. Therefore, we are asking that students DO NOT bring in Valentine cards or treats from home for their friends.

Share Day:

Share day is either on Tuesday, 22nd or Friday, 25th. Please remember that if your child attends both days, to select just one day. We do not have enough time for everyone to have multiple turns. The children may bring something that relates to the curriculum, a book with their favorite page marked, something special to them (not a toy or stuffed animal) or something that they made. If you are not sure of an item, please feel free to ask. Sometimes a toy may be appropriate if it relates to the curriculum.

We will email the families that may sign up for a conference once the sign-up sheet is posted, just to confirm. For any new students that started late this school year, we will schedule a conference in April for them.

negative antigen test to return. We have some tests on hand if you need one. Even with a negative antigen test, we ask that children are still symptom free for 48 hours before returning.
